Notes from the Pastor

Dear Friends and Family,

Have had a couple of questions on how the day Easter falls on is determined each year. Well here it is: Easter is the 1st Sunday after (never on) the Paschal Full Moon. The Paschal Full Moon is the 1st full moon after the spring (vernal) equinox on or after March 21st. Easter will always fall between March 22nd and April 25th. As you can see with Easter being the 27th this year we are just about as early as it can be. We have many events happening in the life of the church before we get to Easter. We are still in the season of Lent and will be in Lent until the Saturday before Passion/Palm Sunday. Holy week then begins on March 20th. Holy Week is filled with scripture readings which I will attach. Holy Thursday is the first service day of the week. We will be able to attend this service at Epworth Memorial in South Bend at 6:30 PM. Next is Good Friday service which will be held at Southlawn at 6:30 PM. Holy Saturday or Easter Vigil, the Paschal or Christ Candle will be put up and lit each Sunday throughout the season of Easter. Easter will be on March 27th and will consist of a Sunrise Service at 7:00 am, followed with breakfast and then the Easter Service at 9:30 am. This is the celebration of our Lord Jesus Christ rising from death to be with his Father in Heaven. We will then stay in the Easter season until the day of Pentecost on April 15th. I urge each of us to read the following scriptures on the day shown for the upcoming Holy week:

Monday (March 21st) - Isaiah 42:1-9, Psalm 36:5-11, Hebrews 9:11-15 and John 12:1-11 Tuesday (March 22nd) - Isaiah 49:1-7, Psalm 71:1-14, 1 Corinthians 1:18-31, and John 12:20-36 Wednesday (March 23rd) - Isaiah 50:4-9a, Psalm 70, Hebrews 12:1-3 and John 13:21-32 Thursday (March 24th) - Exodus 12:1-14, Psalm 116:1-4 12-19, 1 Corinthians 11:23-26, and John 13:1-17 31b-35 Friday (March 25th) - Isaiah 52:13-53:12, Psalm 22, Hebrews 10:16-25, and John 18:1 – 19:42 Saturday (March 26th) - Job 14:1-14, Psalm 31:1-4 15-16, 1 Peter 4:1-8, Matthew 27:57-66

May each of us feast on the Word of God during this season of Lent, Holy week and Easter.

Grace is a freely given gift, just let it live within us with joy and love.


